The website has the scholarship form for easy and instant download. There will also be a copy of the application in next month's newsletter.

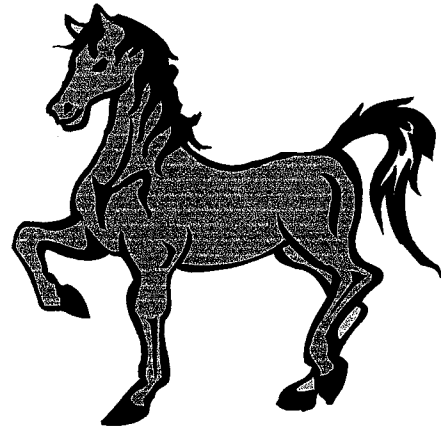
