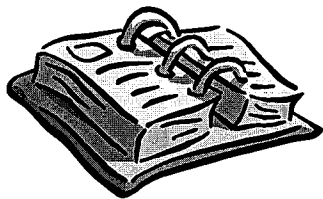

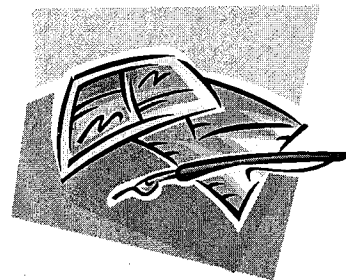
We received several applications for the Norm Dunn Scholarship this year. The committee is reviewing them and we will be able to announce the recipients in the next newsletter.

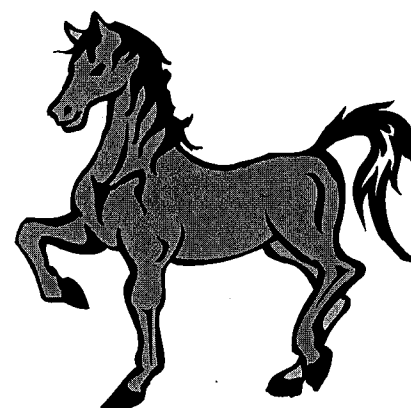
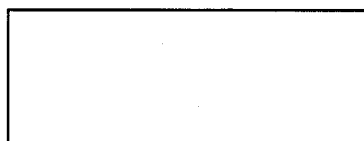
