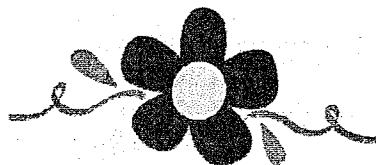

NEW BUSINESS:

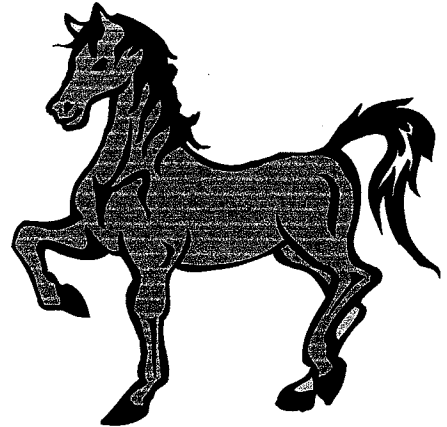
Board Meeting: The October board meeting will be held at the home of Debbie Price. Janet Stevenson will host the December board meeting.
