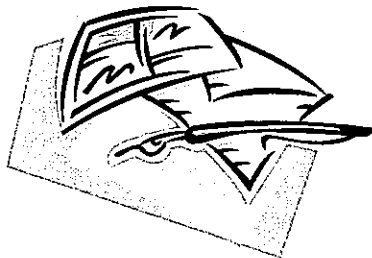

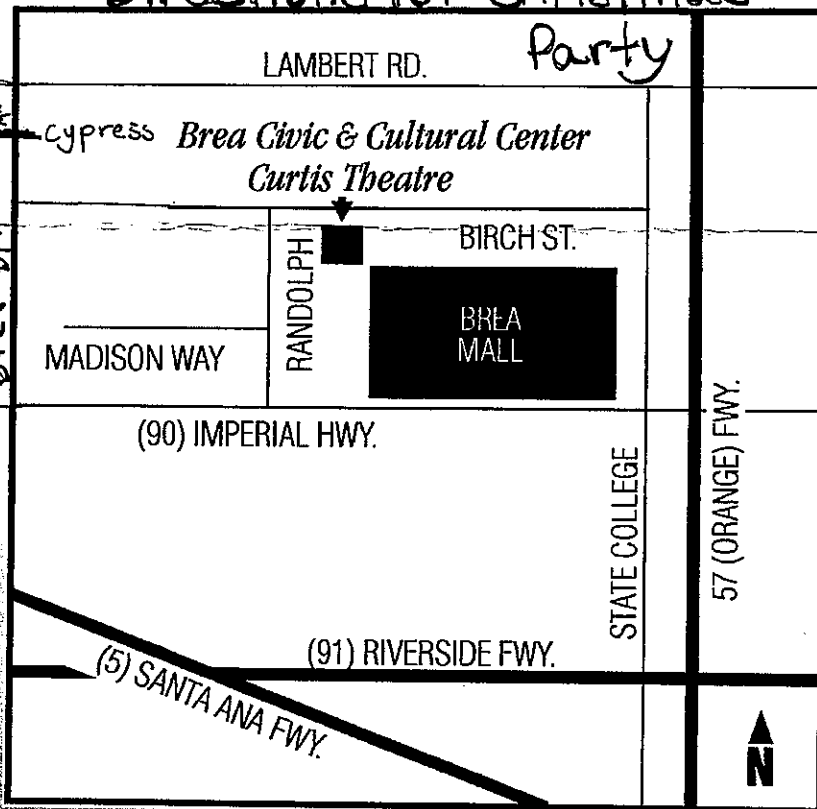

November 8, 2009

The November 8, 2009, board meeting was called to order by Mary Ann Hughes at 4:37 p.m.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Rose Marie Henry reported that there is \$135,362.59 in the treasury. \$125.00 has been received for dues. The seed money for the 2010 show has been reduced to \$8,900.00 from \$10,000.00. The treasurer's report will be filed for audit.

CORRESPONDENCE: Equine Affair will be held February 4th through the 7th at Fairplex. Sue Lease reported that the show steward, Cindy Reid, wrote that the Fall Show was excellent.

Bobbie Werner-Hansen suggested that we have a brochure to use when contacting sponsors. Liz Broadbent reported that her 4-H members got two sponsors and put a thank you in the Fullerton Observer. Sponsor's names will be listed on our web site. Luning issues were discussed and an effort will be made for better communication with exhibitors.

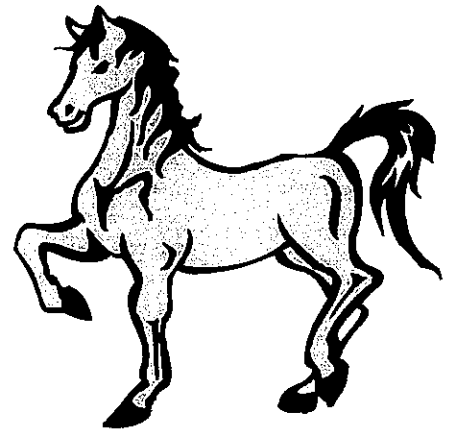
