September 9, 2009

The September 9, 2009 board meeting was called to order by Mary Ann Hughes at 7:45 p.m.

MINUTES: A motion to correct the August, 2009 minutes was made by Eldona Arns and seconded by Bob Barrett. The motion was carried.

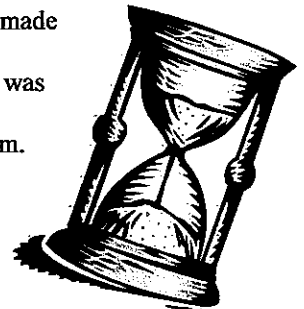
NEW BUSINESS:

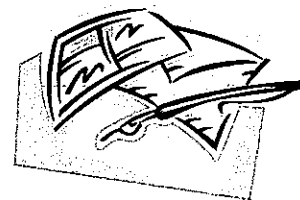

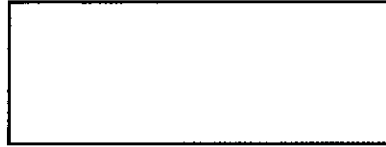

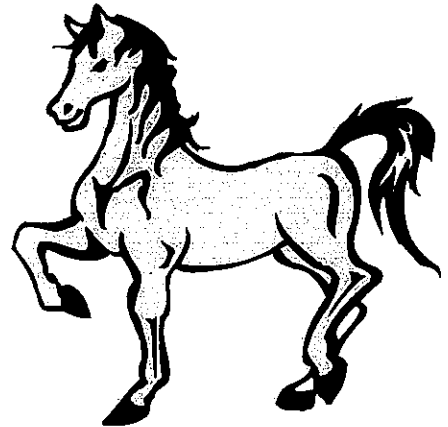
