It is now official that we are going to the Magic Castle for our Christmas party this year.

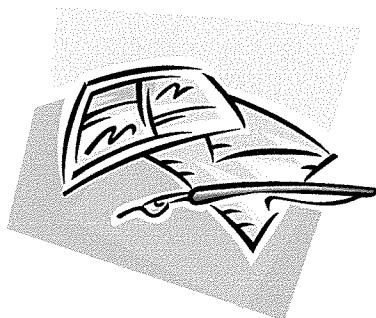

April 6, 2010

The April 2, 2010, board meeting was called to order by Mary Ann Hughes at 8:13 p.m.

ATTENDANCE: Officers: Mary Ann Hughes, Pres. / Dir.; Eldona Arns, Vice President/Dir.; Rose Marie Henry, Treas. /Dir., and Janet Stevenson, Sec. /Dir. Directors: Bob Barrett, Bob Henry, Laurie Henkel, and Debbie Price. Guests: Bill Hughes, Darleene Barrett, and Jane Carlone.

MINUTES: The minutes for the March 2, 2010, board meeting were read. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Laurie Henkel and seconded by Bob Barrett. The motion was carried.
