AHASC 2020 Norm Dunn Scholarship

Rules & Regulations

1. Applicant must currently be a member of AHASC.
2. Applicants must sign and date the application to verify its authenticity. Any fraudulent information will be grounds to revoke the award.
3. Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent, or they must be expecting to graduate this calendar year.
4. The scholarship is awarded to the applicant's school for which they must be used. Upon notification of enrollment, the check will be sent to the recipient in the name of the College or University to which the applicant will be attending. The award is to be used against their educational expenses.
5. A pre-selected Scholarship Committee will determine award recipient based on the merit of the applications received. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
6. All application information will remain in the strictest of confidence by the Scholarship Committee, and all materials received become the property of the AHASC and will not be returned.
7. A neat and complete application must be turned in with the following:
 - An **OFFICIAL, UNOPENED/SEALED**, school transcript from your current institution or your high school, if you are currently in high school. If you are not currently taking classes, use the last institution you attended.
 - An essay, 300 words or less, outlining your future goals and how further education will help you reach those goals.
 - A clear picture of the applicant to be used to announce the scholarship winner in our June newsletter.
 - A copy of the applicants AHA membership card.
 - A letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
8. **All completed applications and support materials must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2020.**
