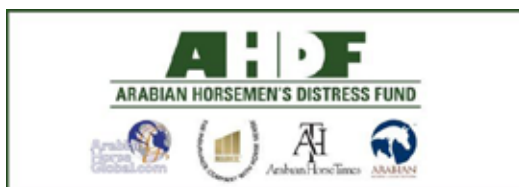

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Entries received without a valid check, or money order payment information will not be processed until payment is received and will be subject to any post entry penalties noted below if payment is postmarked after close of entries.

The owner, trainer, rider/handler, owner's agent, coaches and parents of junior exhibitors must sign and print their names in the waiver section on the reverse side of the entry form.

CLOSING OF ENTRIES

Entries close and must be postmarked by Aug 31, 2022. POST ENTRIES, \$50/horse penalty for horses entered past the close of entries.

SHOW OFFICE

Exhibitors are requested to register promptly at the show office upon arrival. The show office will be open Thursday, Sept 8th, from 9:00am until 5:00 pm and each day throughout the show from 1 hr prior to show start until after the last class of the day. The office will remain open one hour after completion of the last class of the show for close out.

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. GENERAL INFORMATION

ENTRIES

Entries must be submitted on the official entry form for this show. Entries on thermal FAX paper are NOT acceptable. Please print clearly and legibly or use a typewriter to complete the entry form. If additional forms are required please download from AHASC.org or make photocopies (of both sides) or request them from the Show Secretary.

All horses belonging to one owner must be entered together. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear in the "Owner" space. One, and only one, owner can appear on each entry form.

Farm name may not be used unless (1) the stable or farm is the bona fide owner on the horse's papers or (2) the stable or farm name has been registered with USEF (see Article 815) and the number shown on the USEF farm certificate is included in the space provided. If a farm name is used as Owner, the farm must have an AHA Business membership and that Business membership number must be used as the Owner AHA number. A copy of the Business membership card must accompany the entry.

If farm/business/trust-owned horses are shown in Amateur-Owner classes, the USEF farm registration certificate showing names of all the owners of the farm must be included with the entry and all owners of the farm must be members of the immediate family.

If an exhibitor is buying the horse on contract, the buyer may be shown as owner on the entry form, a copy of the contract must be submitted with the entry as proof of ownership. Reminder: horses entered in **AO** classes must have registration papers showing the rider/handler or a member of the exhibitor's family as recorded owners of the horse.

Owner, (or agent), trainer and all riders/drivers/handlers/coaches must sign entry form in the spaces provided. If owner is the trainer, owner must sign on both owner and trainer spaces. (Trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse"). Parent or guardian must sign for junior exhibitor in space provided on back of entry form. Complete qualification data (qualifying class name, show name & date, placing, rider/handler, # of horses in class) must be included in "Qualifications" section on front of entry form (or AHA show results form for horse and/or rider included with entry form) for all entries in Regional Championship classes.

After completing the entry form, mail it together with the following to the address listed below:

- a check (not post-dated) for all fees and charges
- a copy of both sides of the registration papers for ALL horses entered.
- a copy of the AHA & USEF membership cards for owner, trainer and all riders
- a copy of the purchase contract if owner listed on entry is not the owner shown on the registration papers.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

GENERAL INFORMATION

TROPHIES AND RIBBONS

The Arabian Horse Association of Southern California will award prizes to first and ribbons in all classes as follows:

- AHA Equitation Medal Classes - Medal to first, ribbons to 8th
- Regular Performance classes - Award to first, ribbons to 6th
- Championship Performance classes - Award to Champion, ribbons to 6th

Don Beck Memorial Trophy - presented to the winner of the Arabian Country Eng Pleasure, Open Champ
Bob Henry Memorial Award - winner of the largest ATR Western Pleasure Championship, ATR Country
English Pleasure Championship & Hunter Pleasure Championship classes, winner to receive \$100.
Don Beck Memorial Trophy - Champion Arabian Country English Pleasure. Open
Larry Lease Youth Sportmanship Award - winner to receive \$100.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card. Join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in walk/trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with a competition card at AHA Regional and National competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

TWO MINUTE RULE

Due to a full schedule of classes the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes at the completion of final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. "Open" cards may be run for Trail/Reining classes to assist exhibitors who might have a conflict with classes in another arena. Check with show manager or in the show office for details.

RULES

This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation (National Equestrian Federation of the United States), Chapter AR - Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of US Equestrian will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT U.S. EQUESTRIAN RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH. The Show Committee shall decide questions not covered by USEF Rules and its decisions will be final.

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association Inc., and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

Horses shown in the HA/AA section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Partbred Arabian Register). Certificate of Registration issued by the Canadian Partbred Register, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for, and must be entered under their full registered name.

A legible copy of the entire registration papers showing proof of ownership for each horse entered in the show must be submitted with the entry form. In the case of a contract of sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract or lease (containing registered name and number of the horse, date and signature of the seller or lessor) be submitted with a copy of the registration papers.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Arabian Horse Association of Southern California (AHASC), and the 19th Agricultural District not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited any, and shall indemnify the Arabian Horse Association of Southern California (AHASC), and the 19th Agricultural District against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

COPIES OF AHA & USEF MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Owners, trainers, agents, handlers, riders and drivers must provide a legible photocopy of their current AHA and USEF membership cards at time of entry. Reminder! Failure to include copies of the membership cards with entry will result in a late forms fine.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN AOTR, AAOTR, JOTR CLASSES

Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitor or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR 122. (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the arm or entity as defined by USEF GR 122.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted. Horses must be qualified by an amateur owner.

LOCATION OF CLASSES

Show management reserves the right to hold classes, or portions of classes, on the grounds outside the Main Arena if it is found necessary to do so, or to change and/or modify the Schedule of Events as necessary to accommodate the entries received.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize List. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DISCIPLINE

Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse owner, lessee, trainer, groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

Any action(s) against a horse by an exhibitor, which are deemed excessive by a judge, USEF steward or show veterinarian, in the show ring or anywhere on the competition grounds may be punished by official warning, elimination, or other sanctions which may be deemed appropriate by the show committee. Such action(s) could include, but are not limited to excessive use of whips, spurs, or bamboo poles.

FARRIER AND VETERINARIAN

A qualified farrier will be available on the grounds, Thursday, Sept 10th and thereafter throughout the show. Management will employ a California licensed equine veterinarian on call.

RIGHT OF REFUSAL Show management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. All animals are subject to a physical inspection by the Official Show Veterinarian.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS

The State of California and USEF requires that both halter and performance horses entering any show offering prize money will be charged a USEF drug testing fee of \$8.00 and a California drug testing fee of \$8 to help defray the expense of testing. USEF and California rules regarding drugs and medications will be enforced. In addition, an \$15 USEF fee must be charged for each horse entered.

DISQUALIFICATION

Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly, or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made an false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

CANCELLATION OR SUBSTITUTION OF ENTRY

To encourage early entries, the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry, stall and all fees on any horse not fit to show providing written or email notification ahascshowsecretary@gmail.com is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date. Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit all fees, except if a horse is scratched prior to August 20th by written communication to the show secretary, stall fees minus a \$25 handling fee will be refunded and tack/groom room fees will be refunded. No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF Article 1506.2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for ANY reasons will be considered unless such written request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand PRIOR to the show. No exhibitor may withdraw horses from the show after it has commenced, or remove them from the grounds, without the permission of the show manager.

RING PROCEDURE

Towels, Whips & Other Objects. Once an animal is being exhibited in the show ring, there will be no objects of any nature, e.g., towels, whips, treats, etc., passed or transferred from a person on the rail to any exhibitor inside the show ring.

ADMISSION TO THE RING

No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. In all cases requiring attendants in the ring, proper attire is required

STABLING

Permanent box stalls with doors will be available at a fee of \$125.00 each, NO STRAW MAY BE USED. Horses may arrive with not penalty after noon - Sept 8th and must be vacated by Sept 11th

GENERAL INFORMATION

AMATEUR

AMATEUR CERTIFICATION - Only active Federation members may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. (Exception: This is not required for Opportunity classes). This status must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such status provided by the Federation. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Foreign riders requesting Federation Amateur status, must be a Junior, Senior or Life Competing Member of the Federation (Exception: Equine Canada members in possession of current EC membership may sign for USEF Amateur status on a show by show basis at no cost). Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. 2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing. 3. There is no fee for amateur status for Senior Active or Life Members. Such status will expire on November 30th.

DUSTERS

In all classes requiring grooms or other assistants, proper attire is required.

Paddock Area Conduct

There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers. There will be no whips, noise-makers or other equipment, devices, or objects allowed in the paddock area which might disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the area, except the show whip properly carried by a handler in the paddock area.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS

Every horse entered in the show will be assigned a separate identification number. It is important for the proper handling of the show that the correct number be worn by the rider or handler in all classes.

DOGS

The State Humane Officer requires dogs to be confined or on a leash at all times and are not allowed outside the barn area. Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in the grandstand or show office area at any time.

ARENA DIMENSIONS

Indoor Arena a is 317' x 153'; the Outdoor arena is 250' x 125'. All arenas have geotextile footing.

FAILURE TO CANCEL CLASSES OR COMPLETE RIDER CHANGE FORMS

A rider change form must be completed in the show office before the start of the session for any change from rider/handler listed on the entry. All riders/handlers and their member numbers must be reported to AHA for qualification and awards tracking. Exhibitors are required to complete an official scratch form prior to the class for all scratches. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to advise the show office of rider changes or scratches prior to a class; failure to complete rider change or scratch forms prior to the class will result in a \$25 fine and that horse, owner and rider-handler may not show in subsequent classes until the fine is paid at the show office. This courtesy will enable gatemens and the office to function efficiently.

PROTESTS

Should any questions or disputes arise, they must be protested in the manner prescribed by USEF Chapter 6.

TBA

AHASC has allotted space for a limited number of TBA classes. TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of dressage, cutting, reined cow, hunter/jumper. These classes may be placed throughout the schedule but there are only 15 total available. TBA Fee is \$60/class plus the class entry fee. TBAs are given on a first come first served basis only and must be reserved by August 31, 2022 with the show secretary.

Warm up Trail: Warm up trail will be held Thursday afternoon. Time will be posted at show office, The charge is \$15 per horse with unlimited number of goes during the time posted."

GENERAL INFORMATION

VACCINATION RECORDS:

GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhino-pneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. **BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.**
